



Greenhouses and Cottage at top right



Holcombe Cottage - this would be regarded as the principal entrance to Holcombe, approached from the Heath to the left of house



This is probably c.1900. The main entrance to Holcombe would be to the right of the house via the garden. Heaver would have taken the path you see crossing the heath in the foreground on his way to the church



Holcombe gardeners – the greenhouses still exist.



Holy Trinity Church c. 1900 – Heaver would have approached from the top gate which is a bit further to the right of photograph. The main gate is to the left, nearest the village
