

His Majesty King Charles III Coronation Celebrations in Westcott



Westcott celebrated His Majesty King Charles III's Coronation weekend by holding the annual village fair, WESTFest, on Monday 8th May, presenting an opportunity to bring the whole village together.

The iconic Westcott Bus Stop on the Village Green was decorated with bunting and flags and the Official King's Coronation Emblems were fixed to lamp posts along the main road through the village.







The fair was opened by the arrival of the "King & Queen" on a horse and carriage with the school choir singing the National Anthem. Union Jack Flags were given to all the children attending the fair and most of the stalls were decked out with bunting and flags.
