

Quick facts about Surrey Hills primary school

- Approximately 155 children at the school (“on roll”)
- 9 teachers including the Head teacher and Deputy Head
- Now all consolidated on the Westcott site after the Abinger site closed last year
- School vision: “To aspire, grow and succeed together”
- Still a need to grow the pupil roll to ensure that the school remains sustainable – this can be helped by the whole village
- Long term commitment to the school given from the Good Shepherd Trust
- Ofsted visit March 2023 – ‘Outstanding’ grading given for the Early Years
- **Committed** group of parents and governors who endlessly volunteer for different things e.g. Teddy Bears Picnic; helping on school trips; maintaining the library; e-safety workshops for parents; Open the Book Wednesday assemblies
